ADMISSION REQUIREMENT: By state law, a completed Health Statement must be on file before a student can be admitted.

HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONAL'S STATEMENT:

Please note: If your child is newly enrolled with Spanish Schoolhouse, a parent's signature may fulfill this requirement until your child's next doctor appointment. A parent signature is valid only for the first 12 months from the date your child starts our program. After that, Texas State childcare law requires that a healthcare professional's signature must be on file. Note: Families transferring from another SSH location are not considered new families and must have a Health Statement signed by a medical professional.

Varicella for Chickenpox

Varicella, the vaccine for chickenpox, is not required if your child has had chickenpox disease. If your child has had chickenpox, please provide the approximate date or if they received the vaccine, write the date they received vaccine: _____

My child has been examined within the past year by a healthcare professional and is able to participate in the school program. Within 12 months of admission, I will obtain a healthcare professional's signed statement and will submit it to the school.

***Note: All students must submit immunization records or an exemption form (such as an affidavit) to the office along with a signed Health Statement.**
