If your child continues with SSH beyond that date, Texas State childcare law requires that a healthcare professional's signature must be on file.

Varicella for Chickenpox

Varicella, the vaccine for chickenpox, is not required if your child has had chickenpox disease. If your child has had chickenpox, please provide the approximate date or if they received the vaccine, write the date they received vaccine: _____
